Methodology


An analysis of KS2, KS3 and KS4 curriculums was undertaken by all staff

580 Pupil, Parent and Staff surveys were completed
We wanted to create clear connections for pupils, staff and parents; not vacillating between what the **core purpose** is for our curriculum here at the Academy

We wanted to support high expectations that **do not** change based on subject area

Planning for progress rather than *'getting through a curriculum'*; sequential and building on prior learning
Create a framework that encourages high **discretionary effort** (*'It's just what we do here....'*) in our pupils: **build Intrinsic motivation**

Integrity
